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MINUTES OF THE RIDGE MANAGEMENT BOARD MEETING HELD IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE CHIEF SECRETARY, R. NARAYANASWAMI, GNCTD, ON 29th JUNE AT 1100 HRS (2006)

A meeting of the Ridge Management Board constituted under the order of the Hon'ble Apex Court was held under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Govt of NCT of Delhi, in his Conference Room with all the members of the RMB on 29th June, 2006 at 1100 hrs. At the outset, the Chief Secretary, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, extended welcome to the participants of the meeting and highlighted about the need for better co-ordination among the members of the Ridge Management Board, to sort out the issues related to the management of the ridge area.

Beginning the discussions, the Secretary, (Environment and Forests), made a brief presentation on the general issues pertaining to the management of Ridge and the constitution & functioning of the Ridge Management Board.

In the meeting, the following issues were deliberated and decided;

General Protection of the Central and South Central Ridge Area

The Secretary, Environment & Forests, GNCTD presented about the general management, problems of the Central and South Central Ridge in

particular. In the matter, it was intimated that, large scale dumping of malba/entry of trucks was going on in the Central Ridge near Dasghara village. In this regard, photograph depicting same were shown and the photographs of Sanjay Van showing the dumping of malba along the road side boundaries of the ridge /broken boundary wall was also presented in the meeting.

In this regard, Chief Secretary directed that,

- A D. O. to Vice Chairman, DDA from the Chief Secretary be sent giving details of the matter.
- DDA should initiate action against the persons responsible for dumping the garbage/malba along the boundaries of the Central & South Central Ridge (Sanjay Van) and to arrange for the removal of the same, if any, within a week's time.

In the matter, it was also informed by the DDA that the eviction of structures has been held up due to the stay awarded by the Hon'ble High court. In the matter, Chief Secretary directed that, the merits of the case may be brought the notice of the court immediately as the delay in vacation of the stay causes further deterioration of the Ridge. He also suggested that, such facts may also be brought to the notice of the Hon'ble Apex Court as well.

Thereafter, the agenda items were discussed and the decisions taken in the meeting are as below;

AGENDA 1: PROTECTION AND FENCING OF THE CENTRAL RIDGE

The L&D Officer, vide Notification No. Enf 157 (5173)/02 dated 19.05.2004 placed an area of 864 ha in the Central Ridge at the disposal of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi through its Forest Department on **as is where is basis** Out of 864 ha, 441 ha of area is yet to be handed over to the Forest Department. The RMB was informed that, the joint physical verification of the actual extent of the area of the Central Ridge has not been under taken. However, the L&DO informed that, the joint inspection been fixed for July 4, 2006. In the matter, the Chief Secretary directed that,

- the required joint inspection of the sites by the L&DO, CPWD and Forest Department must be completed in a week's time.
- Mr. S C Saxena, B.O., from the office of L&DO, to take up the matter
 with the Mr. Rakesh Kumar, Land and Development Officer, to provide
 the detailed account of the 864 ha of the Central Ridge and the action
 plan prepared for handing over of the remaining land to the Forest
 Department, in a weeks' time,
- a letter be written by the Department of Forests to the Director General, CPWD to hand over the remaining land to the Forest Department.

 the difference in the extent of boundary as per the notification.

AGENDA 12: NON-FOREST ACTIVITIES IN SANJAY VAN

Fencing and boundary wall be repaired/ constructed wherever considered necessary. The MCD should remove all the illegal dhabas constructed along the boundary of the Sanjay Van. The report in this regard be submitted to the RMB by the DDA and MCD with in months' time.

It was also directed to submit a video graphy by the Forest Department and DDA of the illegal dhabas, malba dumping broken walls/fencing and the illegal constructions, if any, as well as of the plantations raised in the Sanjay van, to be presented before the Chief Secretary within 15 days.
