MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF RIDGE MANAGEMENT BOARD HELD ON 08.03.2019AT 4:00PM UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF CHIEF SECRETARY, DELHI & CHAIRMAN, RMB

The meeting of Ridge Management Board was held on 8th March 2019, Friday at 4:00PM under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary cum Chairman RMB. The list of attendees is attached.

At the outset, the Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests & Member Secretary, RMB welcomed all the Board members and briefed about the agenda items for the current meeting.

Thereafter each agenda was discussed by the Board and decisions were taken as listed below:

### 1. Agenda Item 1(A): Demarcation of Ridge Forest area along with fencing of the demarcated area

As desired by the Chairman in the last meeting, a detailed status report, filed jointly by the DCF(South) and DC(South), regarding the demarcation and fencing of Southern Ridge Forest area was put before the Board.

The Chairman asked that the total length of boundary walls constructed and the quantum of forest land protected as a result of the same should also be indicated, along with the length of boundary walls proposed to be constructed and the area to be protected as a result. The Chairman also asked for uniformity in compilation of maps of all villages demarcated as a result of the current exercise and directed that the final maps be made available to all Departments/stake holders so that Ridge Area can be taken into account at the project planning stage itself.

The Chairman desired the next meeting of RMB should be convened in the first week of April to discuss about the updated status of demarcation & fencing of the Southern Ridge.

The above proposal was discussed and keeping in view the need for taking up measures for protection of Ridge forest area, the above stated proposal of Forest Department for the amount of Rs. 18.67 crores was approved by the Board. The Board directed that ex-servicemen be taken as security guards from RajyaSainik Board, and that hiring of drivers should also be attempted from RajyaSainik Board in the first instance, subject to availability.

## 2. Agenda Item 2: Construction of World Class Skill Centre and Delhi Skill University at village Jaunapur, South Delhi

(UA: Department of Training and Technical Education)

The PCCF informed the Board that the said proposal is for construction of World Class Skill Centre and Delhi Skill University at Jaunapur by Department of Training and Technical Education over an area of 15.02 Ha. The proposed construction involves development of Academic Block, Admin Block, Hostel facilities, Workshop and recreational facilities.

As desired by the Board, the site was inspected by the Forest Department jointly with representatives of Revenue Department and User Agency. It was

reported that the proposed construction area (Part-1 and Part-2) is falling within Southern Ridge; Part-1 (8.905 ha.) has 17 nos. of standing trees and Part-2 (5.348 ha.) has 24 nos. standing trees.

Keeping in view the fact that the allotment of Khasras for the said project has been done before the completion of Final Demarcation of Ridge forest area, the Board decided that if the user agency is able to demonstrate availability of equivalent land for compensatory plantation as per requirements of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 along with geo-coordinates, the proposal may be considered for recommendation to CEC subject to the following conditions:

- The User Agency shall obtain necessary permission for diversion of forest area for non-forestry purposes as per provisions under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- ii. The User Agency shall make arrangement for mutation of an equivalent Non-Forest land in favor of Forest Department in lieu of diversion of Forest area under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

Accordingly, the user agency was asked to present the details of land for compensatory plantation in the next meeting of the RMB.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
