The Vice Chairman, DDA and Pr. Secretary (Finance), Members, RMB could not attend the meeting due to their pressing prior commitments.

The Chief Secretary & Chairman, Ridge Management Board (RMB), welcoming the Members and Special Invitees, informed that in pursuance of the decision taken in the last meeting of RMB held on 26.08.2010, the Working Group-II B and the Governing Body of UTTIPEC on 29.10.2010 had approved construction of Slip and Link Road connecting Mehrauli-Mahipalpur Road & Mehrauli-Gurgaon Road for easing out the traffic congestion in the area with certain observations/ suggestions. He thereafter, requested Secretary (E&F) to explain the changes/ modifications incorporated by NHAI in their revised plan under consideration of the Board.

Referring to the minutes of the meeting circulated vide No.F.1(2)/2010/Dir./UTTIPEC/26th/D-364 dated 23.11.2010, Secretary (E&F) & Member, RMB informed that the Governing Body had accepted the recommendations of the Working Group II B of UTTIPEC for construction of the proposed Link and Slip Roads connecting Mehrauli-Mahipalpur Road & Mehrauli - Gurgaon Road with the conditions that the

He further informed that as per the revised plan submitted by NHAI, the area involved in construction of the Link Road and Slip Roads, worked out to 22197 Sq. Mtr. (2.2197 Ha.) against 24126 Sq. Mtr. (2.4126 Ha.) originally proposed by NHAI and entailed removal of 512 trees (Link Road – 481 trees and Slip Road – 31 Trees), details of which were as follows:

A. Link Road connecting MGR and MMR (approx. 500 Mtr.)

i. Private Land : 3294 sq. mtr.
 ii. DMRC Land : 946 sq. mtr.
 iii. DDA Land : 16902 sq. mtr.

Sub total : 21142 sq. mtr. (2.1142 Ha.)

B. Slip Road connecting MMR and MGR (towards Mehrauli approx. 70 Mtr.)

i. Private Land : 301 sq. mtr. ii. DDA Land : <u>754</u> sq. mtr.

Sub total : 1055 sq. mtr. (0.1055 Ha.)

Total (A+B) : 22197 sq. mtr. (2.2197 Ha.)

Shri Ravi Agarwal, Member, RMB expressing his apprehension, pointed out that unless the proposed right of way of 75 Mtr. of Andheria More- Mahipalpur Road was fully utilized, the traffic coming on to the above road from Gurgaon and Andheria More would not ease out the traffic congestion as the existing right of way of Andheria More-Mahipalpur Road would be far too adequate to sustain the additional traffic load on account of the slip and link roads.
